PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AT BOARD MEETINGS

The Board of Education recognizes its responsibility to hear and respond to public comment, and therefore encourages public participation at Board meeting. There will be a specific time at each Board meeting to provide an opportunity to address the Board.

- There will be a sign-up sheet for members of the public wishing to address the Board of Education available at each Board meeting.
- Anyone wishing to speak at public session should fill in their name, address, and the topic or topics they want to speak about.
- People shall speak in order of names on the list.
- Each speaker shall be limited to five minutes total of speaking time.
- Public session shall be limited to a maximum of 30 minutes total. People may also submit any comments in writing to the District Clerk.

The President is responsible for the orderly conduct of the meeting and shall rule on such matters as the time to be allowed for public discussion, the appropriateness of the subject being presented, and suitability of the time for such a presentation. The Board as a whole shall have the final decision in determining the appropriateness of all such rulings.
