Grades Pre-K-6: In-Person Instruction

Monday/Tuesday-Thursday/Friday;

Wednesday- Individualized learning, academic recovery, deep-cleaning day with childcare support provided for school-aged children in grades K-9. All classrooms will be socially distanced. Alternative spaces (gym/cafeteria) will be equipped and used each day to safely accommodate students.

Grades 7-12: Hybrid Model (In-Person and Remote)

Two cohorts: Monday/Tuesday (Group A) and Thursday/Friday (Group B). All classrooms will be socially distanced. Alternative spaces (gym/cafeteria) will be equipped and used each day to safely accommodate students. All students will attend classes based on their master schedules. On scheduled remote days, students will be attending all classes on their schedule virtually. Wednesday- Individualized learning, academic recovery, deep-cleaning day with childcare support provided for school-aged children in grades K-9.
