

**SMOKING**

The Board of Education recognizes the health hazards associated with smoking, and therefore prohibits smoking or the use of tobacco-related products by students in school buildings, on school property, in school buses or at school-sponsored activities.

Chewing tobacco on school property is also prohibited.

Students caught violating this policy will be subject to disciplinary penalties.

The Superintendent of Schools will implement this policy by appropriate regulations and disciplinary codes.

The Board policy on smoking will be prominently posted in each school building.
