The HCS Facilities Committee will provide guidance, vision, and leadership to the facilities planning process.

Major Committee Functions:

- Review the needs and uses of District buildings and grounds, and studies the budgetary impact of improvements.
- Recommend, with input from board of education, administration, faculty, staff, students and community, long and short terms uses and facility improvement plans that are in the best interest of the community and the District.
- Serve as a communications channel for the various constituencies affected by the planning and design of physical facilities, including faculty, staff, students, and surrounding community.
- The committee ensures the 5 Year Facilities Plan is updated and reviewed and includes facility replacement, renovation, and growth are sequenced over time as well as the location of future buildings, walkways, parking, and other infrastructure features.
- Using input from design consultants, facility condition surveys, instructional and student affairs plans, safety/security, IT/telecom, the committee integrates existing facilities conditions and evolving programmatic needs into the planning process.

All decisions shall be reached by consensus or a vote of a simple majority of the total membership of the committee. The group consensus and/or voting of the Policy Committee will be summarized and presented to the Board of Education for review and vote.
