N) **Appoint Special Education Teacher**

It is recommended that Jackie Beamer, who hold a NYS Permanent Certification K-12, Special Education be appointed to a three-year probationary appointment beginning September 1, 2022 and ending August 31, 2025 to the position of Special Education Teacher in the education of children with handicapping conditions – general special education tenure area at a starting salary of \$71,000/year.

* To the extent required by the applicable provisions of Education Law §§2509, 2573, 3212 and 3014, in order to be granted tenure the classroom teacher or building principal shall have received composite or overall annual professional performance review ratings pursuant to Education Law §3012-c and/or 3012-d of either effective or highly effective in at least three (3) of the four (4) preceding years. If the classroom teacher or building principal receives an ineffective composite or overall rating in the final year of the probationary period, he or she shall not be eligible for tenure at that time. For purposes of

this subdivision, *classroom teacher* and *building principal* mean a classroom teacher or building principal as such terms are defined in Sections 30-2.2 and 30-3.2 of this Part.
